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Kyle Michel Credentialed by International Local Government Management Organization

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Kyle Michel, City Administrator of Ashland, Missouri, recently received the Credentialed Manager designation from ICMA, the International City/County Management Association. Mr. Michel is one of over 1,300 local government management professionals currently credentialed through the ICMA Voluntary Credentialing Program.

ICMA's mission is to advance professional local government through leadership, management, innovation, and ethics and by increasing the proficiency of appointed chief administrative officers, assistant administrators, and other employees who serve local governments and regional entities around the world. The organization's 13,000 members in 27 countries also include educators, students, and other local government employees.

To receive the prestigious ICMA credential, a member must have significant experience as a senior management executive in local government; have earned a degree, preferably in public administration or a related field; and demonstrated a commitment to high standards of integrity and to lifelong learning and professional development.

Kyle Michel is qualified by over seven years of professional local government executive experience and is a graduate of Drake University's College of Business and Public Administration with a Master of Public Administration. Prior to his appointment in 2022 as City Administrator of Ashland, Missouri, he served as the City Administrator for Van Meter, Iowa.
