

**PARKS & RECREATION BOARD MINUTES**

Wade Middaugh presented to the Board the wrap-up and review of the Festival including the final budget of expenses and income and the schedule of Fall Festival Committee Meeting dates for 2010. The Board discussed some improvements that can be made to next year's festival.

C. *Home for the Holidays Event*

Wade Middaugh presented the Board with the information on the last Home for the Holidays event and suggested that this year the Board do the City Christmas Tree and a decorating event. Vee Fasciotti suggested that we drop the contest and make a decorating event this year instead. After discussion, the Board decided to have a City Christmas Tree Lighting and a Christmas Ornament Coloring Event to

hang ornaments on a tree inside City Hall. Vee Fasciotti made a motion to approve a budget of \$300.00 for the Home for the Holidays Event to include money for a City Christmas Tree and Ornament Coloring Event.


**OLD BUSINESS:**
