# ***PRESS RELEASE***

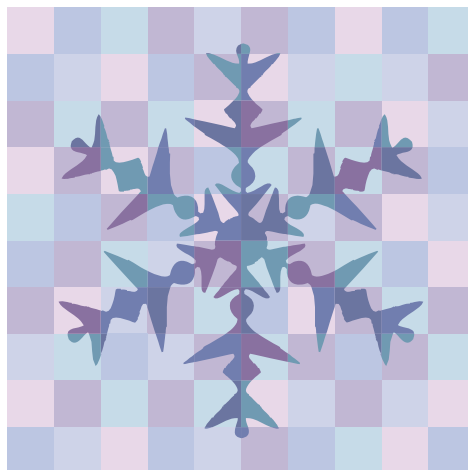

From City Administrator Kelly Henderson:

During a winter weather event, the City of Ashland Street Department will remove snow and ice from the streets and will continue in the "removal" mode until the roads are in satisfactory condition from curb to curb.

During larger events (generally 4" or more accumulation) an announcement will be made that the Street Department is moving from removal operation to "cleanup" mode. Although most streets will have been pushed and widened out, some removal efforts will continue such as city maintained alleys, dead ends, and clearing of intersections during the cleanup procedure.

During this cleanup mode, if an Ashland resident is unable to remove a snow windrow at the end of the driveway or a snow windrow from around a vehicle parked on the shoulder, they may call the street department at 657- 2568, if no response you can then call city hall at 657-2091 to request the city to remove the windrow. Basically, these calls will be handled in the order which they come in. We will attempt to fulfill all requests of this type within twenty four hours of receiving the call and will be handling these calls during normal operational hours.
