



IMPORTANT CHANGES TO ASHLAND'S TRASH SERVICE

Do I have to use one of the new 95 gallon carts?

- No. Residents have the choice to use the 95 gallon cart that will be provided at no additional cost or you may continue using a receptacle that must be weather proof, in good working condition, equipped with handles, and have a minimum capacity of fifty gallons and a maximum capacity of ninety-five gallons.

Can I still set out trash bags at the curb?

- No, only trash in an approved container will be picked up.
- Bags placed at the curb will no longer be accepted after March 1, 2012.

Is the trash schedule changing?

- No, Trash service will continue to be removed twice a week on Tuesdays and Fridays.

What is the new trash rate?

- The rate for trash service beginning March 1, 2012 will be \$10.50/month.
- The collection fee will increase from \$1.00 to \$2.00 per month beginning March 1, 2012.

Are There Any Changes to the Recycling:

- Beginning March 1, 2012 the recycling containers behind City Hall will be emptied more frequently. An empty container will be placed on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- Due to the demand of additional containers, there will be a recycling fee of \$1.00/month to help offset the additional expense.

Allied Waste Services will begin delivering carts curbside on February 15, 2012. All carts are to be delivered no later than February 29, 2012.
